About FAC Summer Day Camps

Campers ages 4-11 (entering 6th grade Fall 2024) will spend their days at FAC East, swimming daily, participating in activities and games in the various locations around the club, and hiking on nearby trail systems and playing at the park.

Camp Counselors - Your campers are in great hands at FAC Summer Day Camps. All of our counselors are CPR/AED certified, have First Aid training, camp training and know how to work effectively and safely with your campers. Their energy and excitement are sure to impress!

Swimming - Campers participate in age-appropriate swim activities and free swim time with counselors and lifeguards every day. *If your child requires a life jacket please notify camp staff and include an appropriate sized coast guard approved PFD with their camp gear.* Group Swim Times: Cubs/Bears 10:30am, Coyotes 1:30pm, Sharks 2:30pm.

Swim Lessons and Camp Swim Team - Campers can be enrolled in a group swim lesson or swim team for an additional fee that is payable with your weeks camp fee. The group lessons are available either M/W or T/Th (Level 1 and Level 2) and Swim Team (Level 3) is every Wed. Counselors and aquatic staff will get them to and from their lesson. Must mark the swim lesson column on the registration page to be registered.

Adventures - Adventures are optional and are an additional fee that is payable with your weeks camp fee.

Adventures are always on Thursdays. Week 4 adventure to Flagstaff Extreme is for Coyotes and Sharks only and is priced differently than other adventures. Week 5 adventure to Lake Mary is for Sharks only. Adventures will only happen if we can secure transportation and the facilities can accommodate our campers and staff. Must mark the adventure column on the registration page to be registered.

Pizza Wednesday - This is optional for your child and a separate fee from camp. Pizza slice options are cheese and pepperoni. Order and cash payment must be received by 9am Wed.
