Our aim is to provide a vibrant and positive experience for each camper by offering well-supervised, enjoyable, and organized daily activities.

The activities are tailored to different age groups, placing emphasis on social and character development, leadership, teamwork, sportsmanship, and overall fun! Our committed and trained staff actively encourage campers to engage in structured team and individual activities, fostering socialization and the opportunity to make new friends during both organized sessions and free time.

Campers are divided into groups based on grade level. Age appropriate activities are scheduled from 9am to 4pm, with each camp group having daily swim time. Campers can be dropped off as early as 7:30am and picked up as late as 5:30pm. We offer a range of options to accommodate the schedules of busy parents and campers, including full weeks, flexible weeks, full week mornings, and full week afternoons. For an additional fee, campers can participate in Thursday adventure days, enroll in Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday group swim lessons, or the Wednesday camp swim team.

Join us from May 28 to August 2 for action-packed days! Camp weeks 2-5 and 7-10 run Monday-Friday, week 1 is Tuesday-Friday and week 6 is Monday-Wednesday (no camp on July 4-5). Registration and any changes must be completed by 4pm on the Thursday preceding the camp week. There is a \$20 fee for registrations or changes received after 4pm Thursday.

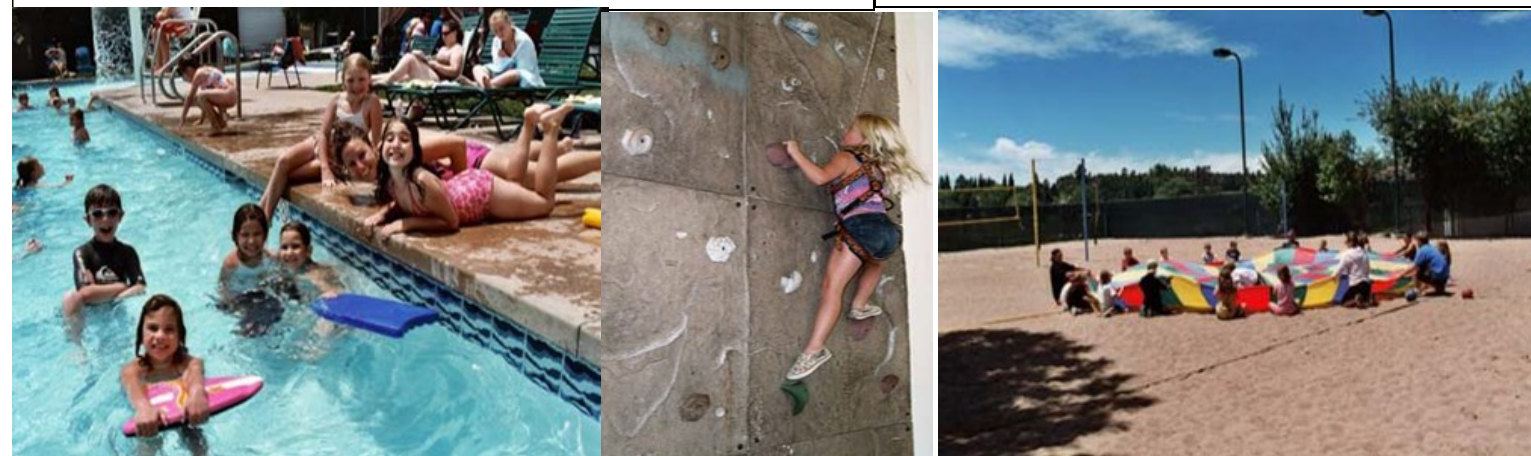

What to bring and what to leave at home

- Campers must bring a lunch, at least two snacks, water bottle, swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, and wear comfortable clothing and closed toed shoes. Please label all of your campers belongings. We recommend two separate bags/packs; one for lunch/snacks and one for all other items.
- Campers must leave at home, all electronics (including phone/smart watch), games, toys, valuables and any personal items not needed for camp. A phone is available for campers at the Camp desk should campers need to contact a parent or guardian.

Pre-registration or changes to current registration is required by 4pm Thursday prior to the camp week camper will attend. After deadline if space is available, there is a \$20 fee for late registrations/changes

- Campers can be dropped off at camp as early as 7:30am and must be picked up no later than 5:30pm

About FAC Summer Day Camps

Campers ages 4-11 (entering 6th grade Fall 2024) will spend their days at FAC East, swimming daily, participating in activities and games in the various locations around the club, and hiking on nearby trail systems and playing at the park.

Camp Counselors - Your campers are in great hands at FAC Summer Day Camps. All of our counselors are CPR/AED certified, have First Aid training, camp training and know how to work effectively and safely with your campers. Their energy and excitement are sure to impress!

Swimming - Campers participate in age-appropriate swim activities and free swim time with counselors and lifeguards every day. *If your child requires a life jacket please notify camp staff and include an appropriate sized coast guard approved PFD with their camp gear.* Group Swim Times: Cubs/Bears 10:30am, Coyotes 1:30pm, Sharks 2:30pm.

Swim Lessons and Camp Swim Team - Campers can be enrolled in a group swim lesson or swim team for an additional fee that is payable with your weeks camp fee. The group lessons are available either M/W or T/Th (Level 1 and Level 2) and Swim Team (Level 3) is every Wed. Counselors and aquatic staff will get them to and from their lesson. Must mark the swim lesson column on the registration page to be registered .

Adventures - Adventures are optional and are an additional fee that is payable with your weeks camp fee. Adventures are always on Thursdays. Week 4 adventure to Flagstaff Extreme is for Coyotes and Sharks only and is priced differently than other adventures. Week 5 adventure to Lake Mary is for Sharks only. Adventures will only happen if we can secure transportation and the facilities can accommodate our campers and staff. Must mark the adventure column on the registration page to be registered .

Pizza Wednesday - This is optional for your child and a separate fee from camp. Pizza slice options are cheese and pepperoni. Order and cash payment must be received by 9am Wed.
